

Snow Plow Plan for accumulation of more than 2”

- 1. BSS will clear all the main lanes and entries to Elk Grove Lane and Mountain West Lane.** *The goal is to have these done before 7am depending on timing of snow fall. If it is a daytime storm will clear the main roads and return in the early morning of the following day to clear any excess snow.*
- 2. BSS will clear Morgan Creek and Annie Glade.** *Street snow will be pushed to the west side of both of those roads. If windrows/berms at the end of each west driveway are taller than 6”, BSS will clean the front of all driveways affected when possible. Note: obstructions may inhibit the ability to do a thorough job.*
- 3. BSS will clear all the cul-de-sacs.** *Snow will be pushed towards the center island and leave as little on the “outside” of the loop as possible.*
- 4. For longer snowstorms and larger accumulations, BSS will continually clear the roads with the main roads as a primary focus and cul-de-sacs secondary.**
- 5. After the snow is removed BSS will treat intersections as appropriate.**
- 6. If snow around the fire hydrants becomes more than 10” deep, BSS will clean around all fire hydrants.**
